

RULES & REGULATIONS

ALL FISH must be treated with the greatest of care, do not keep any fish out of the water for long periods, especially in hot conditions. There is a correct method of ensuring their safety (please ask one of our representatives). **DO NOT IGNORE THIS REQUEST**

DO NOT take fish out of the lake until you have all the necessary equipment ready, i.e. weigh sling (wet), unhooking mat, scales, camera etc

DO NOT move any fish from one swim to another, **DO NOT** carry any fish other than in a proper sling. **DO NOT** stand-up whilst holding the fish

- **NO** unhooking mats or slings (we supply)
- **NO** use of long shank or bent hooks, wide gape short shank only
- **NO** shop made rigs
- NO lead core of any kind to be used or brought on to the premises, hook link and main line material must be mono / no amnesia or any other product similar
- NO shock leaders, snide leaders, fixed leads, or inline leads. All hook links must be weaker than your main line. We recommend 12lb\15lb XT or pro gold mono. Braided mainline and hook link is not allowed
- **NO** bait to be brought (all bait available on site)Prices on bait page.
- NO sacking of fish
- **NO** alcohol to be brought on to the premises
- NO cans
- Rig to be used for fishing Korda type. clips tail rubbers and swivels with zip leads fitted with swivel, antitangle tubing above lead recommended Hooks 4, 6, 8(Available on site.)
- Landing nets must be a minimum of 42inches.
- Rods and reels must be suitable for big carp, no rods under 3lb test and reels must be suitable i.e big pit. Please ask if you require more details
- 2/3 rod limit
- No bait boats other than with prior arrangement, 2 Bic boats on site for customer use

General Care at Paradise Lake

- **NO** litter of any description (this includes cigarette ends)
- **NO** making swims, cutting of trees or any other plants
- **NO** fouling of the complex, toilets are on site
